# From Brussels Airport to the European Forestry House

The most convenient way to get from Brussels Airport to the European Forestry House (Rue du Luxembourg 66, 1000 Brussels) is by bus or taxi:

## 1. BUS

The bus station in Brussels Airport is located on level 0 - one floor down from the arrivals hall – and can be easily reached by using the escalators or elevators.

### MIVB/STIB

The Airport Line is a 30-minute express service between Brussels Airport and the European quarter. The bus stop is Luxembourg. From bus stop to our house is 5 minutes walk. From Monday to Friday 8 pm the Airport Line carries the number 12 and serves the major stops.

Fares:

For 1 journey (purchased outside vehicle): € 3.00

For 1 journey (purchased inside vehicle): € 4.00

For 10 journeys: € 21.00

All MIVB/STIB buses depart from platform C.

## 2. TAXI

Taxis with a taximeter are permanently available in front of the arrivals hall. The fare from the airport to the city centre of Brussels is normally around € 35. Licensed taxis can be recognized by the blue and yellow emblem. Travellers are advised to avoid unlicensed taxis!

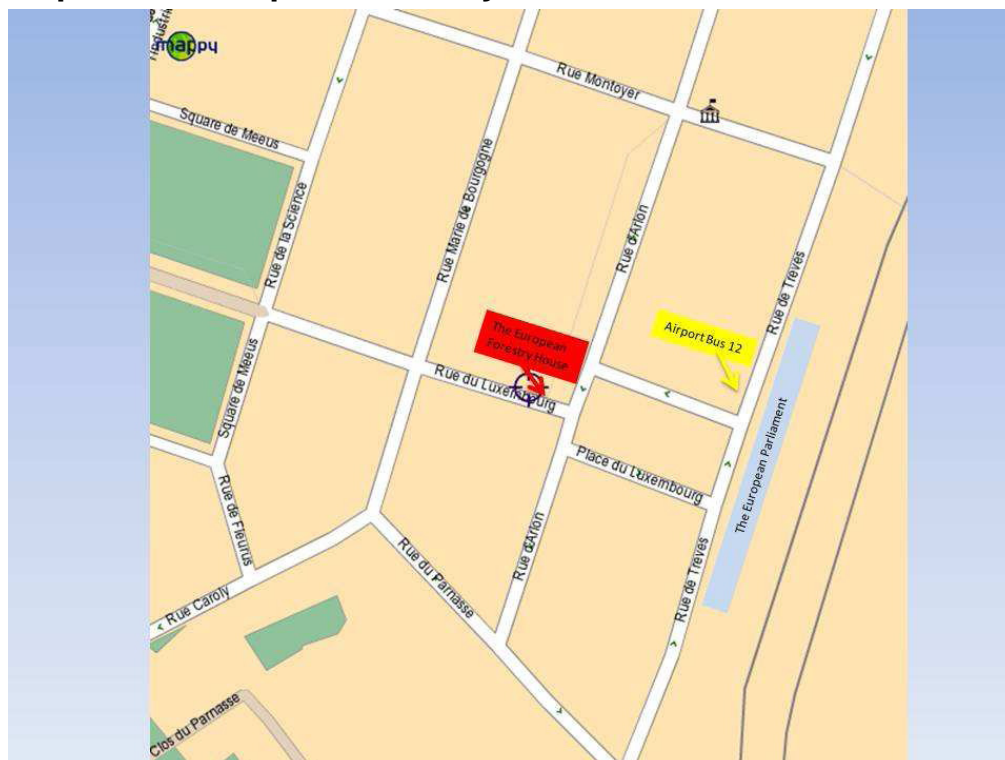
